Philosophy: We hope to provide an outdoor experience for your child and to enhance the student/teacher relationship in a non-classroom atmosphere. Students will enjoy the benefits of cooperative learning (ten to twelve campers per cabin plus one counselor) and making new friends through participation in daily activities with cabin mates and counselors.

Program: Our program is designed to provide the students with firsthand knowledge of the outdoor world and related outdoor sporting activities.
