- Plan for the use of technology to support and differentiate instruction and engage students in the learning process.
- Establish a classroom environment that values positive and meaningful relationships through intentional implementation of the district's SEL and Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports System.
- Collaborate with a variety of stakeholders to address student needs and remove barriers that interfere with academic success.
- Exhibit an ability to work collaboratively within Professional Learning Communities.
- Effectively and efficiently communicate necessary information regularly to students, colleagues, and parents regarding student progress and needs.
