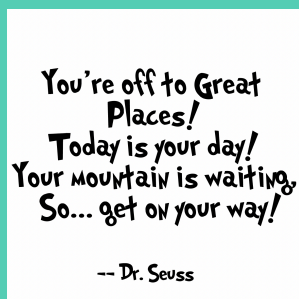


# Welcome to Mrs. Boyd's Class!
